**New Secondary Phase Academy Uniform**

I wrote to you in June to outline the new school uniform from September. In this letter, I explained that the uniform in September 2017 has changed slightly to that currently worn in the Secondary Phase of the Academy. Some parents have expressed a concern regarding the cost of the trousers and others have asked for some clarity.

The decision to change the uniform was a Delta wide change. I understand your concerns and therefore, I have discussed these with the Trust and I have expressed your views.

The Trust have agreed that the uniform for September is as outlined in my previous letter (a copy of this can be found on the website). However, there will be no time limit on the phasing of the trousers. This means that, for Years 8 to 11, as long as trousers are in line with school policy regarding style and fit, these will be deemed acceptable trousers. Year 7 students will be in the logo trousers and the first pair has been provided.

For clarity please see the chart below:

<p>Year 8</p>	<p>All Year 8 students will be provided with a Delta blazer and a Delta tie.</p> <p>Skirts and trousers must be in line with the policy regarding fit and style - no jeans/denim, combats, leggings. Trousers that are too tight or too wide will not be allowed. Skirts should be black and knee length only, not mini or maxi length.</p> <p>The old PE kit is acceptable until such time as they require a replacement and at this time, the Delta PE kit should be purchased.</p>

Year 9	<p>All Year 9 students will be provided with a Delta blazer and a Delta tie.</p> <p>Skirts and trousers must be in line with the policy regarding fit and style - no jeans/denim, combats, leggings. Trousers that are too tight or too wide will not be allowed. Skirts should be black and knee length only, not mini or maxi length.</p> <p>The old PE kit is acceptable until such time as they require a replacement and at this time, the Delta PE kit should be purchased.</p>
Year 10	<p>All Year 10 students will be provided with a Delta tie.</p> <p>The old blazers are acceptable until such time as they require a replacement and at this time the Delta blazer should be purchased. This is the same with the PE kit.</p> <p>Skirts and trousers must be in line with the policy regarding fit and style - no jeans/denim, combats, leggings. Trousers that are too tight or too wide will not be allowed. Skirts should be black and knee length only, not mini or maxi length.</p>
Year 11	<p>All Year 11 students will be provided with a Delta tie.</p> <p>The old blazers are acceptable until such time as they require a replacement and at this time the Delta blazer should be purchased. This is the same with the PE kit.</p> <p>Skirts and trousers must be in line with the policy regarding fit and style - no jeans/denim, combats, leggings. Trousers that are too tight or too wide will not be allowed. Skirts should be black and knee length only, not mini or maxi length.</p>

Uniform can be purchased direct from SPT Uniforms using the link on our website. Any uniform delivered to school will not incur a delivery charge.
